
Vocabulary you will need – horizontal vertical perpendicular parallel

A line that runs from left to right across the page is called a line.


A line that runs straight up and down the page is called a \_\_\_\_\_ line.

Look around your home and out of the window – what vertical and horizontal lines can you see?


Label the horizontal and vertical lines in each of these images.


Lines that never meet are called \_\_\_\_\_\_ lines.
