### Autumn 1:

**Genre:** To learn about a range of fiction stories with predictable and repetitive patterns that link to journeys and adventures

**Text:** The Gruffalo, Handa's surpise and Autumn poems





**Writing Outcomes:** To say/write short sentences using capitals and full stops. To use interesting words to describe a character.

Practise and secure ability to hear and use rhymes.

Key Vocabulary: Capital letter, full stop, finger space, character, rhyme


**Class Reading Book:** We will read a range of picture books linking to PSHE such as The Lion Inside, The Squirrels who Squabbled and The Koala who Could. Books by Rachel Bright.

#### Autumn 2:

**Genre:** To learn about a range of fiction stories with predictable and repetitive patterns that are based on people and families.

**Books:** The Gingerbread man, Jack and the beanstalk, The snowman and Christmas poems.







**Writing outcome**: Children will retell a story, write a postcard and a diary entry. They will continue to use full stops and capital letters.

**Key Vocabulary:** Capital letter, full stop, finger space, character, rhyme

**Class reading books:** Books by author and illustrator Oliver Jeffers including Stuck! The Way Back Home and The Day the Crayons Quit.

**Handwriting:** To practise letter formations.

**Phonics (Read Write Inc. scheme):** extending the basic phonic code and introducing blends and sight vocabulary.

**Speaking & Listening:** Talk for writing – to compose a sentence before writing it. We call this Hold a sentence.

To retell stories using 'beginning/middle/end. Sharing news.




